## Addendum

The purpose of the CHNA report is to provide an overview of the health needs and priorities associated within the INTEGRIS Community Hospital Moore service area. The goal of this report is to provide residents with a deeper understanding of the health needs in their community and help guide the hospitals in their community benefit planning efforts and the development of an implementation strategy to address identified needs. The CHNA involved a review of both quantitative and qualitative data to attain the full scope of the community needs as they pertain to health, with an emphasis on the economically poor and underserved populations.

The 2022 Oklahoma County Community Health Needs Assessment is documentation that INTEGRIS Community Hospital Moore is within compliance with IRS requirements for conducting a community health needs assessment (CHNA). INTEGRIS Health last conducted a CHNA in 2021.

Item 1: Describe the community served – INTEGRIS Community Hospitals serve a broad geographic area. The area established as our “primary service area” is constituted by Oklahoma County, from which **84.7%** of hospital patient visits are drawn. Our secondary service areas include the extended area of Cleveland and Canadian County.

The Affordable Care Act (ACA) requires 501(c)(3), tax-exempt hospitals to conduct a CHNA every three tax years and adopt a strategic implementation plan for addressing identified needs.

Identified priorities for the next year include: **Access to Care** and **Access to Healthy Food**. Many of the initiatives identified and implemented in the previous CHNA will be continued along with new programs.
